

## Whisper Creek Land Use Requirements

The Northeast Florida Hunting Retriever Club member must be in good standing (current on dues) and must sign a property waiver as required by the Property Owner. The property waiver must be hand-delivered at an NEFHRC event (i.e., training day, hunt test, club meeting, etc.).

Members must have a club decal prominently displayed in the back window of their vehicles to access the property on days other than sanctioned club events (i.e., training days, hunt test days, etc.). Members will be provided decals only when a properly signed property waiver has been received. **Decals cannot be mailed; they must be picked up in person.**

Members will receive the combination to the property gates at the time they pick up their decals. Please close and lock the gate each time you enter or exit the property, even if you found the gate open when you arrived.

Be aware of electrical and sewage pipes along the property right-of-way.

Pick up and properly dispose of any trash you find on the property.

If you notice a non-NEFHRC member or a vehicle without a decal, please contact Dan Middleton or an NEFHRC officer right away.

Treat the property as if it was your own.
